

Directions to New Palace - Neues Palais

Address:

New Palace
Park Sanssouci
Am Neuen Palais
14469 Potsdam

The New Palace is located directly on the main tree-lined walk of the park. See also the map below.



Arrival by Car:

From the north: for those travelling down from the north on the A24 highway, change at the Havelland highway junction to the Berliner Ring A10 highway direction towards Potsdam. Get off the highway at the Potsdam Nord exit and take the B273 national road which will bring you directly into the centre of Potsdam.

From the west: those driving in from the west on the A2 highway should change at the Werder motorway junction to the Berliner Ring A10 motorway direction Frankfurt/Oder. Leave the motorway at the Michendorf exit number seventeen and take the B2 national road into the centre of Potsdam.

From the south: whoever is coming from the south on the A9 highway should change at the Potsdam motorway junction to the Berliner Ring A10 motorway. Then leave the motorway at the Michendorf exit number seventeen and take the B2 national road into the centre of Potsdam.

From the east: those driving in from the east on the A13 motorway, should change at the Schönefeld motorway junction to the Berliner Ring motorway A10 in the direction Potsdam (or Hannover) and leave the motorway at the Michendorf exit number seventeen and you will arrive at the centre of Potsdam via the B2 national road.

The best way to reach Potsdam from Berlin is to take the AVUS motorway (A115). You can either leave the motorway at the Babelsberg exit and get to the centre of Potsdam via the Nuthestraße dual carriageway or you can already leave the AVUS at the Berlin-Wannsee exit and take the B1 national road across the Glienicke Brücke bridge directly to Potsdam.

How to Get there by Train

Potsdam is part of the Intercity and Regional railway system of the Deutsche Bahn. Long-distance trains stop at Berlin Zoologischer Garten station, from where you can reach the Potsdam main station within forty-five minutes when you take the S-bahn urban railway. You'll get here even faster if you take a regional express train which goes on to Magdeburg or Brandenburg/Havel.

Getting there by Plane

From Schönefeld airport regional trains and busses connect directly to Potsdam.

From Tegel airport you can take the shuttle bus to the Berlin ZOO station. From there you have the choice of either the S-bahn S-7 urban railway or a regional train to the Potsdam main station.

From Tempelhof airport you use the airport shuttle bus 119 to Yorckstraße station. From there you take the S-bahn S1 urban railway to arrive at Potsdam.

How to Get there by Public Transport

Potsdam can be easily reached from all directions by public transport. You can take trains, S-bahn urban railway and busses. From Berlin the lines S7 and S1 of the S-bahn urban railways as well as certain regional trains will bring you to the Brandenburg state capital. Busses of the Havelbus Verkehrsgesellschaft in particular offer connections to the areas surrounding Potsdam. Within Potsdam's inner city you have the option to board any of the busses and trams run by the Potsdam VIP public transport system.
